## Result area 1 - Water security and water safety for people and ecosystems

### Water

#### RESULTS

The three water activities in the Great Lakes regional programme's portfolio caught up from substantial delays incurred earlier. Maji ya Amani (400000239) completed a water supply scheme in the targeted area, achieving the planned targets. Lake Kivu Monitoring Project (27413) is still lagging behind, but substantial studies were completed and the final major activities have been planned for. In particular, the review of Management Principles for gas exploitation in Lake Kivu will be of major importance for Rwanda and DRC, as they seek to scale up gas exploitation from the lake. Water4Virungas (29453) began to catch up on its targets for water supply, and preparations for substantial further expansion of water supply progressed well during the reported period.

Reasons for result achieved.	but will need further attention. Delays in implementation were caused by problems in procurement (complicated rules that made the processes drag on very long), some staff turnover, and - although this is improving - lack of clout of LKMP management among other stakeholders.
Implications for planning.	Lake Kivu Monitoring Project (27413) was extended by a year. Tight management of the planning will be necessary to make sure everything will be completed within the project period.

Reasons for result achieved.	Achievements for Water4Virungas (29453) still lag behind original plans, but preparations (design, tendering) are in place that will likely enable the project to reach its water supply targets. Maji ya Amani (400000239) has achieved its targets with the completion of the planned water supply scheme.
Implications for planning.	None for Maji ya Amani; for Water4Virungas, a no-cost extension is being considered. Sustainability of operation&maintenance of the constructed infrastructure will
